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What will I learn?

This course is a basic introduction to British Sign Language and Deaf culture, which includes simple vocabulary and understanding the use of BSL structure of communication. By the end of the course, you should be able to introduce yourself and others, ask questions and discuss family, home, weather, and transport. You will also gain an appreciation of some Deaf culture and the way it differs from hearing culture.

What will I need to take part?

Writing materials, notebook. Your tutor will advise regarding course textbooks.

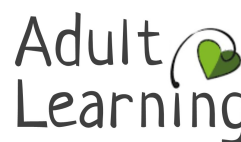
(Online courses only)

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Course eligibility and fees

This adult learning course is available to residents of Northamptonshire who are:

- aged 19 or over on 31st August in the funding year
- resident in England, outside a devolved adult skills funding area.
- ordinarily resident in the UK on the first day of learning.

If you don't meet the above requirements, including some international students or people not ordinarily resident in the UK, you will not be able to attend this course.

Asylum seekers may be eligible to attend in some circumstances, including where they have lived in the UK for 6 months or longer while their claim is being considered, or where they receive certain types of local authority support.

Fees are payable on enrolment as published on the booking page.

If you are in receipt of certain benefits or in employment and earning below £25,750 a year, you may be eligible for reduced fees.

Under certain circumstances you may be asked to provide evidence of your identity, residency, prior qualifications and where relevant, benefits or income.
